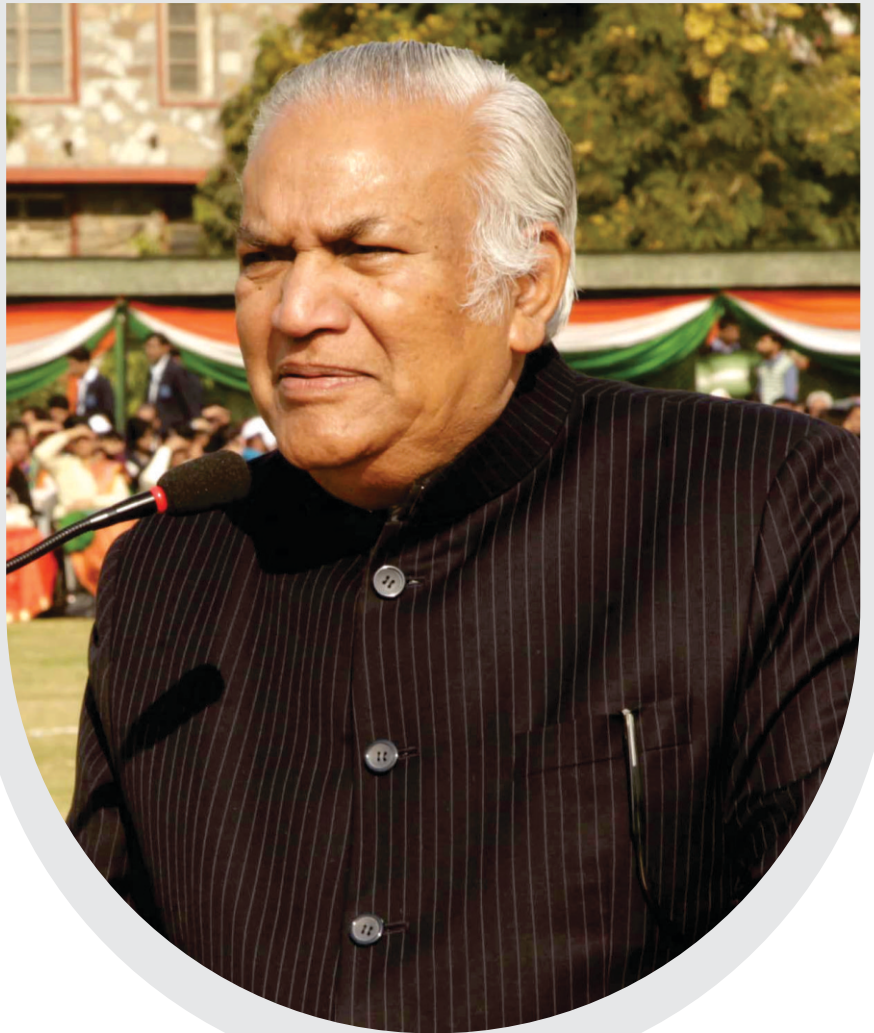

National Education Policy- 2020 envisions a massive transformation in education through– “an education system rooted in Indian ethos that contributes directly to transforming India sustainably into an equitable and vibrant knowledge society, by providing high quality education to all, thereby making India a global knowledge superpower.” The NEP-2020 is founded on the five guiding pillars: Access, Equity, Quality, Affordability and Accountability. It will prepare our youth to meet the diverse national and global challenges of the present and the future.

Subodh stands as a beacon of readiness to embrace positive changes wholeheartedly and NEP-2020 is a paradigm shift in the educational history of India. Our college stands as a prime example of promptness and excellence, seamlessly adopts, absorb, and effectively implement the New Education Policy in alignment with the University of Rajasthan's directives. The following steps have been taken by the college for the successful execution of NEP:

The Semester Scheme: The National Education Policy (NEP) 2020, introduced by the Government of India, is a comprehensive framework aimed at transforming the education system. It lays out broad principles and higher goals and also provides guidelines for the restructuring of educational curricula, assessment methods, and pedagogical approaches.

The NEP emphasizes the adoption of a multidisciplinary approach, flexibility in curriculum design, and the integration of vocational education at various stages of learning. It also encourages continuous and comprehensive evaluation rather than relying solely on end-of-semester exams. Under NEP, higher education institutions are encouraged to offer flexibility in choosing courses, allowing students to pursue a broad-based education while also specializing in their areas of interest. The policy also emphasizes the importance of experiential learning, internships, and hands-on practical training to ensure holistic development. One Academic session comprises two semesters: Odd (July to December) and Even (January to June).

Internal Examination Cell:

New Education Policy-2020 that is a path breaking step in the history Academic charter of India. For the smooth conduction of NEP-2020 the college has constituted an Internal Examination Cell that looks after all the necessary schemes and steps for qualitative continuous assessment.

Mid Term Examination:

Mid Term exam conduction is compulsory in every semester and its scoring will be added in aggregate of End Semester examination.

Attendance:

In NEP-2020 the role of attendance lies in its contribution to creating conducive learning environments, promoting student engagement and equity, tracing the dropout rates and supporting the overall objectives and principles outlined in the policy.

Assignment:

In the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020, assignment plays a crucial role in fostering learning and assessment practices. Assignment serves as a means to promote holistic development, promote critical thinking and creativity, and assess students' competencies in a manner that aligns with the goals of the new education policy. It is mandatory for every student to submit the assignment in both semesters.

Internship:

Internship plays a central, mandatory role in the National Education Policy-2020 by shifting the focus from rote learning to experiential learning and skill development. Its designed to bridge the gap between academic theory and industry expectations, ultimately making students highly employable upon graduation. Internship spanning 120 hours is now embedded into undergraduate programs, earning students valid academic credits.

Process: How To Get Into

Admission Procedure

1. Application for admission must be made in the prescribed form available in the office.
2. Admission form along with Prospectus can be collected on remittance of requisite fee.
3. The duly filled application form shall be submitted to the office either by hand or online before the stipulated date.
4. Minimum eligibility criteria for application to the course shall be as per the Department of College Education Rajasthan and University of Rajasthan norms.
5. Eligibility Criteria
 - For B.A./B.Com. Semester I and II :
 - Minimum 45% of aggregate marks in last qualifying exam (10+2) for students from RBSE / CBSE and any other equivalent Board
 - Minimum 60% of aggregate marks for students who has qualify his last exam (10+2) out of Rajasthan and also who is not the resident of Rajasthan.
6. Students seeking admission in B.A. Semester I will choose three optional Subjects from the groups mentioned above.
7. Candidate admitted to the college must deposit the requisite college fee at the respective Fee counter through one of the following ways:
 - Demand Draft / Pay Order of any Bank in favor of “**S.S. Jain Subodh Commerce & Arts College**” payable at Jaipur.
 - Online fee submission through Net Banking / Credit Card / Debit Card / Phone pay/ Paytm by link given on College website <http://www.subodhcomartscollege.com>
8. Respective documents must be duly attached with the admission form in order to avail the benefit of Sports, NCC, NSS, and Scout before the declaration of the cut off list.
9. In case of online fees deposition by the student, confirmation of admission shall be made only after the deposition of original documents and collection of the FEE RECEIPT by the student from the college office only.
10. A weightage of 3% will be given to Jain minority candidates in all courses at time of admission. If the candidate has claimed more than one weightage then only one highest weightage will be given.
11. Decision taken by the admission committee will be treated as final. All the disputes are subject Jaipur Jurisdiction only.

4. पाठ्यक्रम के लिए आवेदन के लिए न्यूनतम पात्रता मानदंड राजस्थान के कॉलेज शिक्षा विभाग और राजस्थान विश्वविद्यालय के मानकों के अनुसार होगा।
5. पात्रता मानदंड
 - बी.ए. / बी.कॉम सेमेस्टर प्रथम के लिए:
 - आरबीएसई / सीबीएसई और किसी अन्य समकक्ष बोर्ड से विद्यार्थियों के लिए पिछले योग्यता परीक्षा (10+2) में कुल अंकों का न्यूनतम 45%
 - राजस्थान के बाहर की किसी भी योग्यता परीक्षा (10+2) में कुल अंकों का न्यूनतम 60% और जो राजस्थान के निवासी नहीं है।
6. बी.ए. सेमेस्टर प्रथम में प्रवेश चाहने वाले छात्रों को ऊपर वर्णित समूहों में से तीन

7. कॉलेज में प्रवेश पाने वाले उम्मीदवार को निम्नलिखित तरीकों में से किसी एक के माध्यम से संबंधित शुल्क कार्डर पर अपेक्षित कॉलेज शुल्क जमा करना होगा:
 - 'एस. एस. जैन सुबोध कॉमर्स एंड आर्ट्स कॉलेज जयपुर' के पक्ष में भी बैंक का डिमांड ड्राफ्ट / भुगतान आदेश।

8. खेल, एन सी सी, एन एस एस और रोवर्स का लाभ उठाने के लिए संबंधित दस्त को प्रवेश पत्र के साथ विधिवत संलग्न किया जाना चाहिए।
9. विद्यार्थी द्वारा ऑनलाइन फीस जमा करवाने की स्थिति में प्रवेश की पुष्टि दस्तावेज जमा करवाने तथा विद्यार्थी द्वारा कॉलेज कार्यालय से फीस रसीद करने के पश्चात ही की जाएगी।
10. प्रवेश के समय जैन अल्पसंख्यक अभ्यर्थियों को सभी पाठ्यक्रमों में 3% का वेटेज दिया जाएगा। यदि अभ्यर्थी ने एक से अधिक वेटेज का दावा किया है तो केवल एक उच्चतम वेटेज दिया जाएगा।
11. प्रवेश समिति द्वारा लिया गया निर्णय अंतिम माना जाएगा। सभी विवाद जयपुर क्षेत्राधिकार के अधीन हैं।

Right of Rejection / Denial of Admission



Right of Rejection / Denial of Admission

1. Principal has the right to reject the admission under following circumstances:
 - ❖ In case the applicant has hidden any related fact willingly.
 - ❖ In case the applicant has not deposited application form and fees within the stipulated time or he has submitted the incomplete form.
 - ❖ In case the candidate does not fulfill the admission norms of University of Rajasthan.
 - ❖ In case the applicant was punished for using unfair means during his University exams.
 - ❖ In case he has been corrupted/misbehaved during the college hours with any member of the institution.
 - ❖ In case the applicant indulged in the use of unfair means like bribery or terror in order to take admission in college.
2. In case of non-availability of seat admission shall not be given to those students who want admission in the same class for the purpose of improvement of marks.
3. The eligibility of a candidate is ascertain on the basis of the minimum passing marks, instead of the marks obtained in the paper/subject of supplementary exam shall be taken into consideration.

4. Based on the above rules if a candidate has been admitted as a regular student, but has failed in the supplementary exams, then his regular admission will be automatically cancelled.
5. The regular students, who are eligible for Semester III, V, VII Part III must fill their re-admission forms and deposit requisite fee within 15 days from the date of declaration of the result, otherwise they may be denied admission in the course.

अस्वीकृति / प्रवेश से इनकार का अधिकार

1. प्राचार्य को निम्नलिखित परिस्थितियों में प्रवेश अस्वीकार करने का अधिकार है:
 - यदि आवेदक ने कोई संबंधित तथ्य जान बूझकर छिपाया हो। यदि आवेदक ने निर्धारित समय में आवेदनपत्र और शुल्क जमा नहीं किया हो या उसने अधूरा फॉर्म जमा किया हो।
 - यदि अभ्यर्थी राजस्थान विश्वविद्यालय के प्रवेश मानदंडों को पूरा नहीं करता हो। यदि आवेदक को बोर्ड परीक्षा के दौरान अनुचित साधनों का उपयोग करने के लिए दंडित किया गया हो।
 - यदि वह बोर्ड की अवधि के दौरान संस्था के किसी सदस्य के साथ भ्रष्ट / दुर्व्यवहार करता हो।
 - यदि आवेदक ने कॉलेज में प्रवेश लेने के लिए रिश्वत या आतंक जैसे अनुचित साधनों का उपयोग किया हो।
2. सीट उपलब्ध होने की स्थिति में उन विद्यार्थियों को प्रवेश नहीं दिया जाएगा जो अंकों में सुधार के उद्देश्य से उसी कक्षा में प्रवेश चाहते हैं।
3. किसी अभ्यर्थी की पात्रता न्यूनतम उत्तीर्ण अंकों के आधार पर निर्धारित की जाएगी, न कि पूरक परीक्षा के पेपर / विषय में प्राप्त अंकों को ध्यान में रखा जाएगा।
4. उपरोक्त नियमों के आधार पर यदि किसी अभ्यर्थी को नियमित विद्यार्थी के रूप में प्रवेश मिला है, लेकिन वह पूरक परीक्षा में अनुत्तीर्ण हो गया है, तो उसका नियमित प्रवेश स्वतः ही निस्त हो जाएगा।
5. नियमित विद्यार्थी, जो सेमेस्टर III, V, VII एवं पार्ट III के लिए पात्र हैं, उन्हें परिणाम घोषित होने की तिथि से 15 दिन के भीतर अपना पुनः प्रवेश फॉर्म भरना होगा तथा अपेक्षित शुल्क जमा करना होगा, अन्यथा उन्हें पाठ्यक्रम में प्रवेश से वंचित किया जा सकता है।


Rules Regulations

Rules & Regulations

1. Principal has the right to do amendments in the rules published in prospectus.
2. Changes if any, in the syllabus by the University of Rajasthan will be applicable as such.
3. Students, taking admission for the first time in the university, must submit duly filled enrollment form along with the examination form in order to get themselves enrolled in University of Rajasthan. Information related to enrollment and examination will be displayed on the notice board.
4. No change will be made once the optional subject is allotted to a student. Principal has the right to allow for any changes in the allotment of subject within 10 days of admission only in unfavorable condition.
5. Students themselves shall be responsible for the attendance record. Teachers will keep their respective students updated about the attendance at the end of every month. Students, failing to stand the 75% of attendance (as per the norms of University of Rajasthan), have to appear in examination as non-collegiate candidate.
6. Students whose result is declared late by the University, attendance will be counted from the 10th day of result declaration or admission date whichever is earlier. No relaxation will be entertained for attendance in any circumstances. If anyone is found guilty towards his academics, no relaxation will be given for attendance.
7. Relaxation in attendance for the students participating in sports or academic activities will be considered only when they fall short of it. Otherwise, not any such case will be considered.
8. Students can take part only in one of these activities i.e. Games/NSS/Rovers.
9. Class arrangements for Arts and Commerce students have been made for both Hindi and English medium.
10. Academic evaluation of students: "Term Tests" are conducted in order to make students familiar with examination pattern and to develop their answering skills. Faculty members evaluate the answer sheets and try to make betterment in the student's performance. Parents / Guardians are regularly informed about the progress of their ward.
11. The entry in the college premises is only by the college identity card. Therefore, every student should wear identity-card daily so that it is visible to all.
12. Parents / Guardians should timely keep themselves informed about the progress of their ward. They can communicate with the concerned head and related faculty members.
13. Parents / Guardians will be responsible for the character, behavior and due fee of their ward.
14. Students must park their vehicle in the parking zone and get the receipt of token fee. Their vehicles must have the registration number in order to avoid any inconvenience. Student himself will be responsible if he parks his vehicle on other than the allotted parking area. Four wheelers of the students are not allowed in the college campus.

नियम और शर्तें

1. प्राचार्य को विवरणिका में प्रकाशित नियमों में संशोधन करने का अधिकार होगा।
2. राजस्थान विश्वविद्यालय द्वारा पाठ्यक्रम में यदि कोई परिवर्तन किया जाता है, तो वह यथावत लागू होगा।
3. विश्वविद्यालय में प्रथम बार प्रवेश लेने वाले विद्यार्थियों को राजस्थान विश्वविद्यालय में नामांकन कराने के लिए परीक्षा फार्म के साथ नामांकन फार्म भी पूर्णरूप से भरना होगा। नामांकन एवं परीक्षा से संबंधित सूचना नोटिस बोर्ड पर प्रदर्शित की जाएगी।
4. विद्यार्थी को वैकल्पिक विषय आवंटित होने के बाद उसमें कोई परिवर्तन नहीं किया जाएगा। प्राचार्य को प्रवेश के 15दिन के भीतर विषय आवंटन में किसी भी प्रकार के परिवर्तन की अनुमति देने का अधिकार होगा, कंबल प्रति कूल परिस्थितियों में।
5. उपस्थिति रिकॉर्ड के लिए विद्यार्थी स्वयं जिम्मेदार होंगे। शिक्षक प्रत्येक माह के अंत में अपने विद्यार्थियों की उपस्थिति के बारे में अद्यतन जानकारी रखेंगे। 75 प्रतिशत उपस्थिति (राजस्थान विश्वविद्यालय के मानदंडों के अनुसार) प्राप्त न करने वाले विद्यार्थियों को गैर-महाविद्यालयीन अभ्यर्थी के रूप में परीक्षा देनी होगी।
6. जिन विद्यार्थियों का परिणाम विश्वविद्यालय द्वारा विलम्ब से घोषित किया जाता है, उनकी उपस्थिति परिणाम घोषित होने के 10 वें दिन अथवा प्रवेश तिथि, जो भी पहले हो, से गिनी जाएगी।
7. किसी भी परिस्थिति में उपस्थिति में कोई छूट नहीं दी जाएगी। यदि कोई विद्यार्थी अपनी पढ़ाई में दोषी पाया जाता है, तो उसे उपस्थिति में कोई छूट नहीं दी जाएगी। खेलकूद अथवा शैक्षणिक गतिविधियों में भाग लेने वाले विद्यार्थियों के लिए उपस्थिति में छूट तभी दी जाएगी, जब वे इसमें कम होंगे। अन्यथा, ऐसे किसी भी मामले पर विचार नहीं किया जाएगा।
8. विद्यार्थी इनमें से किसी एक गतिविधि अर्थात खेलधूप.एस.एस.धोवर्स में ही भाग ले सकते हैं।
9. कला एवं वाणिज्य के विद्यार्थियों के लिए हिंदी एवं अंग्रेजी दोनों माध्यमों की कक्षाओं की व्यवस्था की गई है।
10. विद्यार्थियों का शैक्षणिक मूल्यांकन विद्यार्थियों को परीक्षा पैटर्न से परिचित कराने तथा उनके उत्तर देने के कौशल को विकसित करने के लिए "टर्मटेस्ट" आयोजित किए जाते हैं। संकाय सदस्य उत्तर पुस्तिकाओं का मूल्यांकन करते हैं तथा विद्यार्थी को प्रदर्शन में सुधार लाने का प्रयास करते हैं। माता-पिता/अभिभावकों को उनके बच्चे की प्रगति के बारे में नियमित रूप से सूचित किया जाता है।
11. महाविद्यालय परिसर में प्रवेश केवल महाविद्यालय के परिचय-पत्र द्वारा ही होता है। इसलिए प्रत्येक विद्यार्थी को प्रतिदिन परिचय-पत्र पहनना चाहिए, ताकि वह सभी को दिखाई दे।
12. माता-पिता/अभिरक्षक को अपने बच्चे की प्रगति के बारे में समय-समय पर जानकारी रखनी चाहिए। वे संबंधित प्राचार्य एवं संबंधित संकाय सदस्यों से संवाद कर सकते हैं।
13. माता-पिता/अभिरक्षक अपने बच्चे के चरित्र, व्यवहार एवं देय शुल्क के लिए स्वयं जिम्मेदार होंगे।
14. विद्यार्थी अपने वाहन पार्किंग क्षेत्र में पार्क करें तथा टोकन शुल्क की रसीद अवश्य प्राप्त करें। किसी भी असुविधा से बचने के लिए उनके वाहन पर पंजीकरण संख्या अवश्य होनी चाहिए। यदि विद्यार्थी अपने वाहन को आवंटित पार्किंग क्षेत्र के अलावा अन्य स्थान पर पार्क करता है, तो इसके लिए वह स्वयं जिम्मेदार होगा। विद्यार्थियों के चार पहिया वाहन महाविद्यालय परिसर में प्रवेश वर्जित हैं।



Discipline & Code of Conduct

The aim of the college is teaching and research. Inherent in this aim is the responsibility of the college to educate its students to be a responsible citizen. College students must carry a good character and behavior so that they can be the role model of the college. The code of conduct of student outlines the student's behavior and disciplinary guidelines that must pertain to him at college.

Any student found responsible for the violation of any clause outlined in this section is subject to disciplinary action. In order to maintain the dignity of Subodh, all the students must follow/adhere to the rules strictly.

Following are the rules and regulations which act as guidelines for the students

1. Every student must attend the classes regularly with proper uniform and identity card.
2. Any change in contact details of the student/ parent/ guardian or home address should be notified to college office.
3. As per Supreme Court verdict, Ragging is a punishable offence and therefore such activities are strictly prohibited for the college students in or outside the campus. FIR will be registered against such students who are found involved in ragging or other similar activities.
4. Smoking, chewing tobacco, liquor consumption etc. are strictly prohibited. If any student is found involved in aforesaid activities. Then action must be taken against him.
5. Unruly behavior, offensive gestures, usage of slang and abusive language will be counted in the jurisdiction of misconduct. Any such activities or behaviors are prohibited by the college authority and are a punishable act.
6. Damage, defacement, or destruction of college property in any of the form will be a punishable offence.
7. Do not use cell phone in the Classroom.
8. Keep the college clean, use dustbins.
9. Noise or unwanted clamor that disrupts the academic environment shall not be acceptable and in case of violation, strict disciplinary action will be taken.
10. Marking of proxy attendance is a punishable act.

The Code of Conduct cannot assure all eventualities, so we should use our common sense, and be responsible for your actions.

Student Election

So, any kind of student's politics or unnecessary interference and alliance of the political issues is strictly prohibited in the college premises. Rules & Regulations of Fee

1. Deposition of fee is mandatory at the time of Admission.
2. The Student shall deposit the fee online on college website <http://www.subodhcomartscollege.com> or pay by Demand Draft or pay order in favour of **S. S. Jain Subodh Commerce & Arts College, Jaipur** or by UPI at College Fee counter.
3. Students are strictly advised to deposit their fee at the authorized counter of the college. It is for the information of the student that only authorized person is responsible to collect the fee, on behalf of the college administration, no one else.
4. **Fee once deposited shall not be refund under any circumstances.**
5. Student shall pay the fee for the entire session, irrespective of the fact whether; admission is being taken in the beginning or mid-session.
6. The information regarding university examination fee will be displayed on the notice board timely. Students are required to deposit the fee with the examination form before the last date declared by the university. The college will not be responsible for any lapse on the part of student regarding to apply and submission of University examination form.
7. Meritorious and talented students will also be entitled for free-ship and textbooks, in case they apply for the same.
8. Meritorious but financially weak students will be entitled for relaxation in tuition fee. No other relaxation will be granted. Financial assistance will be made available from "Students Assistance Fund". Those who wish to take assistance from this fund may also apply on prescribed application form in the month of December. Relaxation will be granted by the free-ship committee.
9. The caution money will be returned on completion of course only through account payee cheque only. If the student does not collect his caution money within a year, the money will be transfer to Student Alumni Fund. The application form for refund of caution money can be collected in the month of December.

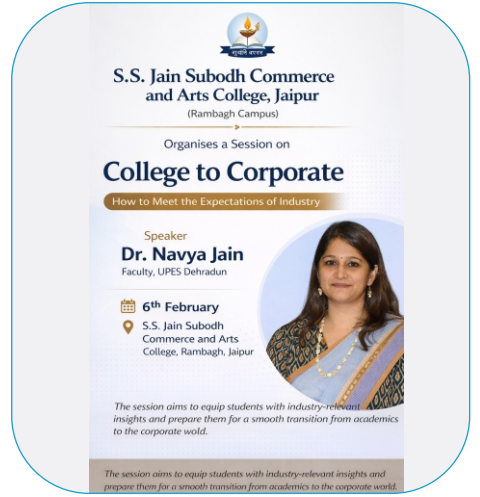
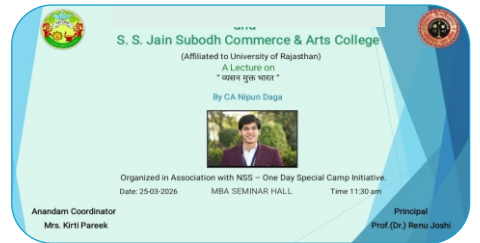


Co-curricular Activities
